New Brownies Unit

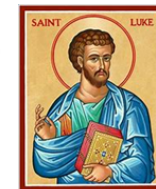
For girls age 7 - 10 years

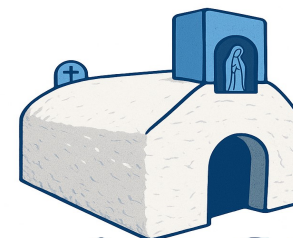
